We are the Monument of the Americas, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization devoted to the creative conception, practical execution, and maintenance of an inspired, unprecedented sculpture and garden park dedicated to celebrating the Book of Mormon, Jesus Christ and his teachings, and the destiny and legacy of America as the Promised Land. When completed, the park will feature over 50 world-class, fine art bronze statues and sculptures (some over 18 feet tall), majestic water features including a waterfall and 40-foot, three-tier fountain, and a classically-inspired visitors and events center, all to be set amid a beautifully manicured landscape on a stunning six-acre site in blossoming Heber Valley, Utah. The park will be a quiet place of introspection and inspiration. It will also be a place for community to gather, with an outdoor amphitheater for concerts, plays, and devotionals, and a visitors and events center equipped to host community and private events, art education, and conferences.

With over 25 years invested in the conceptual and planning process, we have made amazing progress and are now ready to embark on making this vision a reality: the site has been acquired and Heber City is thrilled to have the park be part of their community as a cultural center and tourist attraction; the garden plan has been drafted; all the 50+ statues have been created in their preliminary size and some already enlarged

to their final monument size (most to be life size or greater); and our list of sponsors and partners is growing exponentially. We are pleased to announce a significant financial gift from Senator Gordon H. Smith, which will be used to enlarge one of the central statues, “The Title of Liberty,” of which we will be specifically highlighting in this package.

During this exciting time as we transition from conceptual design to construction of the park’s various components, we are looking for committed financial partners to bring the remaining components of the master plan to fruition.



a Generational piece

Introducing THE TITLE OF LIBERTY: a piece to be passed down through generations, paying tribute to America and her promised destiny of liberty. Standing at over 40 inches tall and 36 inches wide, this awe inspiring piece showcases 7 dramatic figures and an abundance of symbolism.

Seen from one angle, Captain Moroni's Title of Liberty becomes the American flag. Seen from another, the Title of Liberty is hoisted on a pole held in place by soldiers, just as they did at Iwo Jima. Soldiers from different American wars, including the Civil War, World War II, and Desert Storm, represent the countless numbers of American men and women who have been willing to give their all in the defense of liberty. George Washington, the Father of our Country, holds up an infant--the young nation of the United States--delivered into his hands by Lady Liberty. The infant grasps the Title of Liberty in its hand, preparing to carry the standard of freedom into the future.

a Promised Land

AMERICA IS A COVENANT LAND, whose promise of freedom for the faithful has been declared since ancient times by Book of Mormon prophets who saw our day. Kept apart for the latter day restoration of his gospel, the United States was founded on His principles by inspired men and women raised up for that very purpose.


When his peoples' freedom was threatened, the Captain Moroni created and hoisted the Title of Liberty: "In memory of our God, our religion, and freedom, and peace, our wives and our children." He rallied others who shared his desire to ensure liberty continued to reign. At a dire time during the Revolutionary War, George Washington gave a nearly identical speech to Moroni, urging his soldiers to reenlist just as they were ready to return home at the end of their commissioned duty. Washington's speech was able to rally his soldiers in continuing the fight for freedom. It was later said, "God Almighty inclined their hearts to listen to the proposal and they engaged anew".

THE MONUMENT OF THE AMERICAS is the conceptual and creative brain child of Dr. Steven Neal, a facial plastic surgeon and classical artist from Eastern Oregon. His natural artistic ability

combined with his love for the Savior led him to envision a sculpture park that would tell of Jesus Christ, proclaim the story of the Book of Mormon, and honor the promise of America. After two decades, over a million dollars of investment, tens of thousands of labor hours, the completion of all 50+ statue preliminary maquettes and the acquisition of the 6-acre site, the project is taking on a life of its own. It is gaining the momentum

to inspire others to join in and create a cultural treasure that will be cherished and added to by future generations.

Everything about the Monument of the Americas is the product of inspired vision, and visiting will be an unforgettable experience. Set on a lush, centrally located plot with mature trees and a stream running through, the park will stand as a cultural and religious gem in the blossoming Heber Valley. It will serve as a place for locals to visit, gather, and connect as a community, as well as be a destination for visitors.






THE PARK will feature a beautiful, classically inspired visitors center constructed of local red sandstone, with space for public and private events, community art education, and rotating art and cultural exhibits. The colonnaded back terrace will lead visitors directly on to an ellipse walkway serving as the principal artery of the park. The path's sides will be flanked with 20 magnificent bas relief panels, each sized at an impressive 7 x 10 feet, telling the Book of Mormon story in a dramatic fashion. At one end of the central ellipse will stand the twice life-size "Title of Liberty" statue, surrounded by several figures of our nation's Founding Fathers and Mothers. The other end will boast an impressive waterfall feature cascading into a pool below, atop which will stand the 18-foot central statue of Christ.

Off the center of the main pathway, a classical archway will lead to the garden dedicated to the Zion society Christ established in America in the book of Third Nephi. The central, awe inspiring feature will be a 40 feet, three-tier water fountain feature with over 15 statues depicting the Savior blessing the children as angels descend and surround them.


The park will also host an outdoor amphitheater for community gatherings and concerts. The garden will also be host to several meandering pathways with additional statues throughout.




our Legacy
